

# INSTALLATION GUIDE FOR DXO OPTICS PRO 5 ON MAC OS 10.6 SNOW LEOPARD

## DxO Optics Pro v5

You will find a step-by-step procedure to install DxO Optics Pro 5 on Mac OS 10.6 Snow Leopard.

**Important notice :** DxO Optics Pro 5 is not officially supported on Mac OS 10.6 Snow Leopard. DxO Optics Pro 5 is not fully functional on Mac OS 10.6 and DxO Labs does not recommend upgrading your Operating System to Mac OS 10.6 Snow Leopard if DxO Optics Pro is an integral part of your workflow.

If you have determined that you **must** use Snow Leopard with v5.x, the following step-by-step procedure will help you to install and to get around the installation errors and the major limitation of the program.



Please note that the first tab, the “Select” tab will not work on Mac OS 10.6 Snow Leopard (see workaround at the end of this document).




DxO Labs is working on a version of DxO Optics Pro compatible with Snow Leopard. The date of availability is not known yet.

Once you have downloaded DxO Optics Pro 5, double click on "Install" to start the installation.



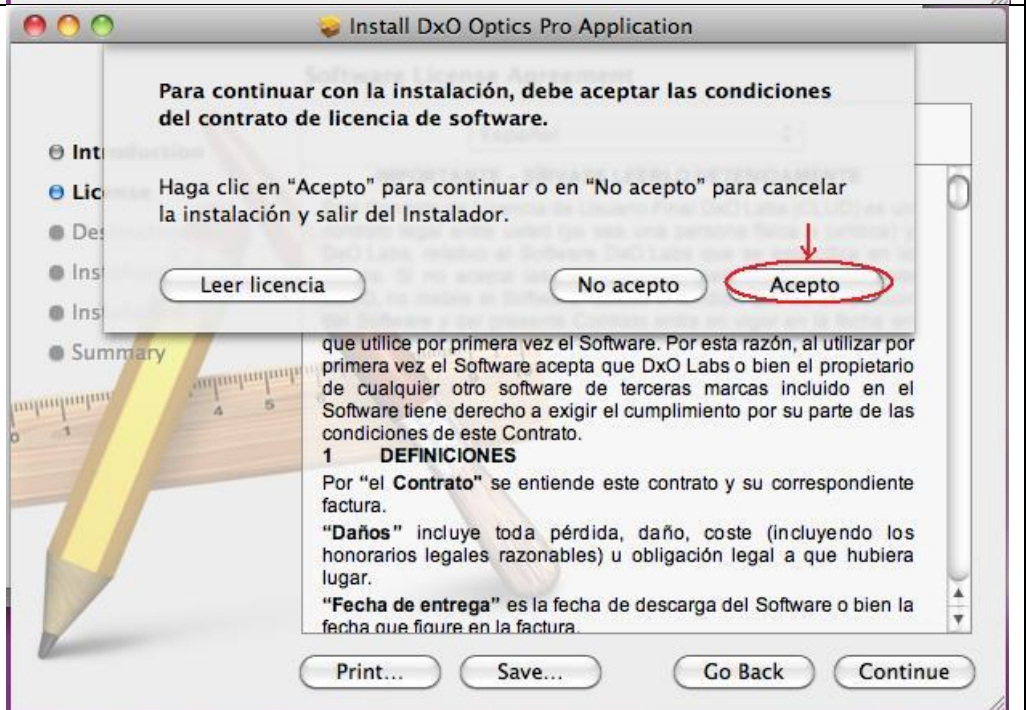

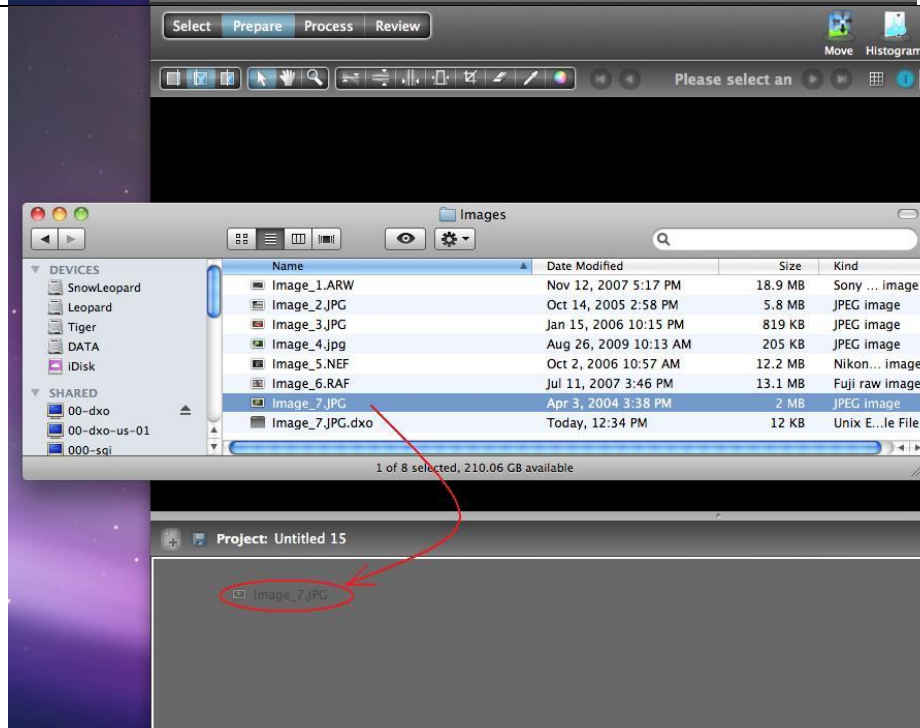
#### 4. STEP 4 - HOW TO IMPORT FILE INTO DXO OPTICS PRO 5

The major limitation of Optics Pro on Mac OS10.6 is with the “Select” tab. This tab is not working. No folders or files will appear on the select tab screen other than the names of the installed hard drives. Image files can be added to Optics Pro by starting Finder along with Optics Pro and dragging and dropping the files in to the lower filmstrip (Project) window.

Using the Finder, you can search folder content in either column view, list view, or thumbnail view



With your mouse click/drag them from the folders in which the images reside into the Project pane and drop the images.



They should be added to your project Window.
